November 1st 1950 saw a change in the unit organization, the 207th Air Service Group was eliminated and the base went under the wing base plan. This included the forming of the following units; 107th Medical Group, Col Wade B. Ellis; 107th Air Base Group, Col Henry H.

Harper; and the 107th M&S Group, Lt Col Joseph W. Manske. The wing was under the command of Col Robert J. Kirsch. The 107th Fighter Group was destined to be moved to Syracuse on the 1st of July 1951.
