OPERATIONS

January 2000—107th Combat Weather Flight members made a deployment to train Puerto Rican and Honduran law enforcement agencies in counter-drug operations.

April 2003—9 members of the 127th Combat Weather Flight were recognized for outstanding work while deployed in Afghanistan. This included the issuance of three bronze stars, among the commendations. The mission of the Combat Weather Flight personnel was to provide weather information to warfighting commanders. The hazards of such missions were all too abundant, since the Combat Weather Flight personnel would often have to enter a combat environment ahead of the main warfighting force to gather their invaluable information.

September 2005—MSgt. Peter Barberi from the 127th Combat Weather Flight became the first ANG member to graduate from Air Force Advanced Skills Training at Hurlbert Field, FL. The training program teaches advanced survival and combat techniques for special operations.

November 2006—Members of the 107th Weather Flight deployed to Iraq for four months to provide support for the 3/20th Special Forces Group.

June 2007—the 107th Weather Flight was named 2006 Outstanding Air Force Reserve Component Weather Flight for its performance in combat operations in Southwest Asia.

June 2010—The 107th Weather Flight conducted parachute jump qualification training at Selfridge ANGB.
