Redesignated Headquarters, 134 Balloon Group, 1924

Withdrawn from the National Guard and demobilized, 17 Sep 1927

Constituted in the National Guard in 1921 as 13th Balloon Group Headquarters, assigned to the IV Corps, and allotted to the state of Georgia. Savannah, GA, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Redesignated as Headquarters, 34th Balloon Group on 25 January 1923. Unit placed on the deferred list 2 July 1923 as a Deferred National Guard (DNG) unit, and replaced in the mobilization plan by the 54th Balloon Group (DNG). Redesignated as Headquarters, 134th Balloon Group in 1924. Withdrawn from the National Guard on 17 September 1927 and demobilized.
