Per bend Silver Gray and checky, Sable and of the first, overall a bend Argent, all within a

diminished bordure Or. Attached below the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "140TH MISSION SUPPORT GROUP" in Blue letters. Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The bend is an ancient symbol of military honor. The checky is a term used to express the field when divided into small squares of alternating colors, as on a checker board. These divisions are representative of planned military organization, as the game of chess is representative of strategy, skill and organization to accomplish or win the objective.
