The 149th Spruce was formed September 1918 at Garibaldi, Oregon. In same month, as part of the split-up of the 135th Spruce, they moved to Wheeler, Oregon, Wheeler Lumber Co. In November 1918, the unit was moved to Vancouver Barracks for demobilization, and were mustered out of the Army in January 1919. Unit had 6 officers and 229 enlisted men.
