## Decorations

### EMBLEM

On a disc Tenné, issuing from a base a demi-globe Azure, land masses Vert, above an aircraft affronte wings fesswise Argent, detailed Sable, all within a bordure of the second. Attached above the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "155TH AIRCRAFT GENERATION SQ" in Blue letters. Attached below the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "MAINTAINING FLIGHT" in Blue letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The globe symbolizes the wisdom, youth and adaptability of the unit's personnel. The aircraft signifies the pride and strength as well as the positive and faithful attitude of the personnel within the unit.
