and was commanded by Maj. Charles Prentiss. Maj. James Kurita took over in 1978. In 1980,

Maj. Vincent Nishina assumed command.

24 November 1982. In response to Hurricane Iwa, which did hundreds of millions of dollar worth of damage to Hawaii, members of the Air Guard's 202nd Air Traffic Control Flight of Kauai maintained the only official communications channel that remained open between the island and the rest of the world during the worst of the storm.
