On 1 Jun 1966, the 231<sup>st</sup> Communications Squadron (Mobile) was reorganized to better delineate the air traffic control function. The parent unit was named the 231<sup>st</sup> Mobile Communications Squadron (Bare Base) with a separate 231<sup>st</sup> Flight Facilities Flight taking over the responsibility for air traffic control operations. The squadron consisted of six officers and 118 enlisted, and the flight consisted of three officers and 45 enlisted.
