Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 15 October 1921, assigned to the 7th Attack Wing (Fifth Army), and allotted to the Third Corps Area. Initiated in April 1922 with headquarters at Franklin, PA. Relocated by April 1923 to Richmond, VA. Inactivated 14 August 1929 at Richmond by relief of personnel. Reorganized and redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 305th Attack Group on 1 October 1933.
