### EMBLEM

On a disc Vert, a scroll unrolled bendwise Argent, shaded Silver Gray, surmounted by a quill pen bendwise sinister nib Or, plumed Gules, veined of the field, in sinister a mullet of the second

fimbriated of the third, charged with a torteau, all entoured by a cog wheel of eight denticles Yellow, all within a narrow border of the last. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "STRENGTH THROUGH SUPPORT" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "305TH LOGISTICS SUPPORT SQ" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The quill and scroll signify the support and strength of the unit to accomplish its goals. The star represents the heritage of the United States Air Force. The gear is for the integral role of the Squadron within the Group.
