Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 306th Balloon Company, assigned to the 42nd Balloon Group (redesignated as the 542nd Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Second Corps Area. Initiated in November 1921 at Atlantic City, NJ. Inactivated about September 1934 at Atlantic City by relief of personnel. Trenton, NJ, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Redesignated as the 306th Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Inactivated about September 1937 at Trenton by relief of personnel.
