Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 308th Balloon Company, assigned to the 42nd Balloon Group (redesignated as the 542nd Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Second Corps Area. Initiated on 27 March 1922 at Buffalo, NY. Redesignated as the 308th Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Inactivated by January 1932 at Buffalo by relief of personnel. Status: Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
