The 309th Commodities Maintenance Group is the Air Force Technical Repair Center (TRC) for aircraft landing gear repair and overhaul of struts, wheels and brakes. The Group repairs and overhauls aircraft fuel tanks, screw jacks, ejection seats; repairs and overhauls gas turbine engines, airframe mounted accessory drives, jet fuel starters, and auxiliary power units. The 309th is the only AF facility to overhaul 20mm guns.
