## **OPERATIONS**

Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 310th Balloon Company, assigned to the 43rd Balloon Group (redesignated as the 543rd Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Third Corps Area. Initiated in September 1922 at Greensburg, PA. Inactivated about May 1928 at Greensburg by relief of personnel. Redesignated as the 310th Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Pittsburgh Airport at Pittsburgh, PA, designated as headquarters on reorganization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Status: Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
