## **OPERATIONS**

The Army Air Forces activated the Wendover Sub-Depot under the immediate command of the Ogden Air Depot, Hill Field for technical and administrative control. It became the 317th Sub-Depot on 20 September 1942. 25 Apr 1942

The Army Air Forces transferred jurisdiction of the 317th Sub-Depot, Wendover Field from the Ogden Air Service Command to the Second Air Force, 1 Jan 1944

Ogden served in that effort through its own facilities and manpower as well as through the 317th Sub-Depot at Wendover Field, which the Air Corps activated on 25 April 1942 under Ogden's jurisdiction. By 24 October 1942 the 317th had two squadrons with 426 enlisted men and 14 officers helping train and support bomber crews.
