Select Mather Units Inactivate. Mather, long the home of navigator training, was another base scheduled for closure on 30 September 1993. As more and more of the navigator training mission transferred to the 12th Flying Training Wing at Randolph, ATC began to inactivate some of the main units. Effective 31 May 1993, the command inactivated the 323d Operations Group; the 452d, 453d, 454th, and 455th Flying Training Squadrons; the 323d Operations Support Squadron; and the 323d Support Group.
