Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 324th Balloon Company, assigned to the 46th Balloon Group (redesignated as the 546th Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Initiated on 24 November 1922 at Appleton, WI. Relocated on 28 July 1925 to Belleville, IL. Inactivated on 1 December 1929 at Belleville by relief of personnel. Reorganized by June 1930 at Belleville. Redesignated as the 324th Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Inactivated about March 1939 at Belleville by relief of personnel. Status: Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
