MISSION

The 325th Mission Support Squadron is one of six squadrons assigned to the 325th Mission Support Group, 325th Fighter Wing, Tyndall Air Force Base, Fla. The squadron provides a full range of services in support of the 325th FW's mission. The squadron is composed of the Military Personnel Flight, First Term Airmen Center, Civilian Personnel Flight, Family Support Flight, Manpower and Organization Flight, Education Services Center, Airman Leadership School, and the Career Assistance Advisor.

Members of the squadron provide personnel services to all active duty and retired military members and their families; furnish the Tyndall community with a variety of services needed by appropriated fund employees, managers, and supervisors; advise Tyndall personnel on educational services including degree programs, professional military education, and distance learning opportunities; ensure improved mission performance and insightful planning through manpower and organization; offer a wide range of services and programs dealing with the concerns and needs of today's military family; provide an environment for Tyndall's first-term Airmen to develop a warrior spirit and an expeditionary mindset; provide high quality Professional Military Education to senior Airmen to give them the prerequisites to become highly effective supervisors and rating officials; and, is the principal advisor to commanders and supervisors on retention issues.

The Manpower and Organization Flight was added to the squadron in October 2004 as part of a Headquarters, Air Force-directed merger between personnel and manpower. During the same time, the career assistance advisor position was repositioned to the squadron and the FTAC was realigned directly under the CAA. The 325th MSS continues to provide support to the 325th FW

by orchestrating military and civilian personnel programs, base education, manpower and organization, family support, the ALS, and the FTAC.
