LTC Allen was relieved as commanding officer of the 326<sup>th</sup> Ferrying Squadron and named air executive of the Group. He was succeeded by Captain Francis W. Foreman. The squadron later

transferred to the IX Air Force Service Command after the group "had been assigned to the 302d Transport Wing and the Air Service Command, of the United States Strategic Air Forces in Europe.
