Initiated in April 1922 at Leavenworth, KS. Relocated on 26 May 1926 to Kansas City, MO. Relocated on 12 October 1931 to Des Moines, IA. Redesignated as the 328th Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Conducted annual summer training at Scott Field, IL, 1922-40. Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
