Squadron mission was to carry ground troops and auxiliary combat equipment to effective locations in a combat zone, maintain combat reinforcements, supply and resupply units in the combat zone, and evacuate casualties and other personnel from such zones." Seeing that this unit was be carrying cargo into the heart of the battle, it was designated a Combat Cargo Squadron.
