From July 10, 1944 to October 15, 1946, the 330th Transport Squadron (Cargo and Mail), which replaced the Troop Carrier Detachment, Antilles Air Command, carried out air courier functions,

operating from Borinquen Field.

1946 On January 2nd, the 4th Tactical Reconnaissance Squadron was reduced to "paper" unit status, with aircraft placed in storage and its remaining personnel transferred to 330th Transport Squadron.
