Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 31 March 1924, assigned to the XVI Corps, and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Initiated on 8 May 1926 with headquarters at Evanston, IL. Inactivated 30 March 1929 at Evanston by relief of personnel. Chicago, IL, designated as headquarters on reorganization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Reorganized and redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 334th Observation Group on 1 October 1933. Location 7 December 1941—Inactive. Disbanded 31 May 1942.
