The 334th Troop Carrier Squadron, operating from Borinquen Field (later Ramey AFB) transported 12,202 passengers and 13,755,666 pounds of cargo between October 15, 1946 and August 1, 1948.

334th Troop Carrier Squadron on July 17, 1947, completed one of their largest post-war air operations by moving an entire battalion of the 65th Infantry from Waller Field, Trinidad, to Isla Grande, San Juan, Puerto Rico, in a single day.
