as the 549th Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Ninth Corps Area. Initiated in April 1922 at Los Angeles, CA. Inactivated on 1 September 1928 at Los Angeles by relief of personnel. Conducted annual summer training at Ross Field, CA. Demobilized on 1 October 1933.
