

## 341 MAINTENANCE GROUP



### MISSION

The 341 Maintenance Group provides the maximum number of fully modernized, combat capable Minuteman III missiles and the command and control required to execute launch per higher command authority. The Air Force has made significant commitments to extend the service life of the ICBM force with nearly \$6.2 billion committed to life-extension programs. Those commitments have worked their way down to the 341 Maintenance Group's level, resulting in tangible improvements to the combat capability of Malmstrom's Minuteman IIIs. The units of the 341 Maintenance Group include the 341 Missile Maintenance Squadron and the 341 Maintenance Operations Squadron.
