EMBLEM

On a disc per bend sinister nebuly Azure and Or, in dexter chief a cross couped Gules fimbriated

Argent (Silver Gray) surmounted by a Rod of Aesculapius Vert, the serpent of the second, eyed of the third, at sinister base a stylized eagle, stooping of the first garnished Silver Gray, all within a narrow border Black. Attached above the disc, a Silver Gray scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "PROCINCTI PER SALUTEM" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a Silver Gray scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "347TH AEROMEDICAL-DENTAL SQ" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The red cross embellished by The Rod of Aesculapius represents the healing and life-giving powers of the unit. The eagle denotes the aviation mission of the Air Force. The interlocking graphic background alludes to the union of aviation and medicine.
