Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 31 March 1924, assigned to the General Headquarters Reserve, and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Initiated on 8 May 1926 with headquarters at Milwaukee, IL. Relocated on 7 January 1927 to Chicago, IL. Reorganized and redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 350th Bombardment Group on 1 October 1933. Inactivated 1 December 1929 at Chicago by relief of personnel. Reorganized by June 1937 with headquarters at Chicago. Disbanded 31 May 1942.
