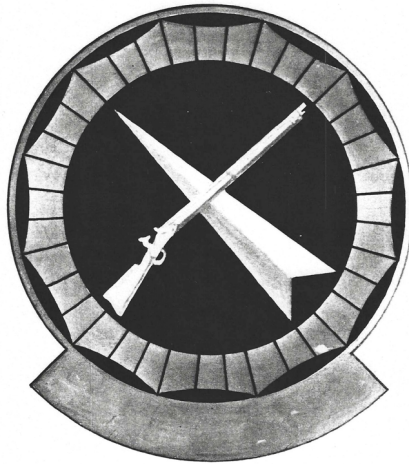

EMBLEM

On a blue disc edged with a narrow yellow border a yellow stylized sunburst voided blue and enveloping a gray and white flight symbol and musket in saltire. SUNBURST: An internationally recognized symbol of police authority. It is found on police badges throughout the world including the United States Air Force Security Police badge. MISSILE: A symbol of the type of weapon system for which the squadron provides security. MUSKET; A symbol of the small arms employed by the squadron to protect the weapon system and indicative of the spirit of the

revolutionary minuteman. Golden Yellow and Ultramarine Blue are USAF colors. Missile and musket in silver. (Approved, 13 Jan 1978)
