

355 LOGISTICS READINESS SQUADRON



MISSION

The 355 Logistics Readiness Squadron plans, supplies and distributes logistical support in-garrison and within the deployed environment while continually supporting the war fighter with anything, anytime, anywhere. The squadron consists of a broad spectrum of diverse flights, including the Vehicle Maintenance Flight, the Materiel Management Flight, the Fuels Management Flight and the Deployment and Distribution Flight, which includes vehicle operators.

Vehicle Maintenance technicians from LRS work to keep the entire Davis-Monthan vehicle fleet in working order. The flight recently proved their expertise while working on a group of seventeen low speed vehicles.

The Materiel Management Flight consists of the EC-130 Parts Store which reviews inventory listings for the EC-130 Compass Call Mobility Readiness Spares Package. The Compass Call's MRSP kits are essential to their deployed mission. Without this support, Compass Call would not be able to deploy at a moment's notice. Under the Deployment and Distribution Flight, Vehicle Operations provides all D-M's official ground transportation service needs from providing aircrew support, to delivering cargo and recovering disabled vehicles. The element is also responsible for issuing government vehicle driver's licenses, managing the Fighter Wing's vehicle misuse program and certifying all bus and tractor/trailer drivers before issuing government licenses.

The Fuels Management Flight is responsible for the storage and delivery of clean, dry petroleum and cryogenic products for Davis-Monthan tenant units and transient customers.
