and allotted to the Third Corps Area. Initiated on 8 November 1921 at Philadelphia, PA. Inactivated on 3 December 1926 at Philadelphia by relief of personnel. Redesignated as the 357th Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
