MISSION

The 369th Recruiting Group is the U.S. Air Force headquarters directing the recruiting activities of eight Health Professions regional flights, and eight enlisted accessions squadrons, servicing a market size of 84 million people with approximately 751 active-duty and 86 civilian personnel. The group's eight recruiting squadrons include the 331st, 332nd, 333rd, 336th, 341st, 344th, 345th and 349th. The 369th RCG is situated in 427 recruiting offices in 17 states covering more than 1.25 million square miles in the U.S. central plains, south central U.S., and Gulf state regions, including the Caribbean.

The group's mission is to support Air Force manning requirements through quality and professional recruits in protecting and defending the United States at any given instance in support of the air expeditionary forces.
