Over and through a light turquoise blue disc, a caricatured white rabbit wearing yellow-orange aviator's helmet, white goggles, a brown belt and holster containing a black and white revolver, holding a commando dagger in teeth, hind legs astride large orange thunderbolt, and sighting and firing a machine gun black and white, resting on front of thunderbolt; cartridge belt yellow-orange, shaded black and white, streaming from side and to rear, empty shells white scattered above gun on blue disc, muzzle emitting flames proper.
