MISSION

The 383 TRS, known as the "Nursing Squadron," is the largest medical training squadron in the Air Force. It is home to the third largest tech training course in the Air Force with the Basic Medical Technician/Corpsman Program graduating over 1400 AF medics annually. The squadron is comprised of 13 officer courses, in addition to the 9 technical training courses.

Develops, conducts, evaluates military and technical training for over 6,000 AD, AF Guard, AF Reserve, Navy, and Army students annually. Staff of 145 manages/instructs 60 officer and enlisted courses and symposia for 839 students/day on site and 350 students/day at 19 separate training locations. Authors nine 5/7 level CDCs. Administers \$417K annual budget and \$7.1M in equipment and facilities.
