Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 15 October 1921 as the 394th Squadron (Pursuit), assigned to the 302<sup>nd</sup> Pursuit Group (Fourth Army), and allotted to the Second Corps Area. Initiated on 6 December 1921 at New Dorp, S.I., NY. Redesignated as the 394th Headquarters Squadron on 25 January 1923 and relieved from the 302nd Pursuit Group. Inactivated on 11 September 1927 at New Dorp by relief of personnel. Relieved from assignment to the Fourth Army 1 October 1933 and assigned to the General Headquarters Reserve. Concurrently, reorganized and redesignated Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 394th Air Depot. Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
