Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as Balloon Park No. 54, assigned to 64th Balloon Group (redesignated as the 564th Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Fifth Corps Area. Redesignated as the 397th Balloon Service Company on 25 January 1923. Initiated in September 1924 at Norton Field, Cincinnati, OH. Inactivated by March 1930 at Cincinnati by relief of personnel. Demobilized on 1 October 1933.
