OPERATIONS

The first commander of the 408th Fighter Group, Kingsley Field, was Colonel Samuel Grashio. In July, 1957, Lt. Col. Raymond A. Thornton assumed command when Colonel Grashio was reassigned to Paine AFB, Washington. The present base commander, Colonel Rupert C. Welch, assumed command in July, 1960, following the reassignment of Colonel Jack W. Williams to Adair Air Force Station, Corvallis, Oregon. In May, 1959, F-101B McDonnell-built "Voodoo" interceptors replaced the F-86L. These supersonic aircraft are flown by pilots of the 322nd Fighter Interceptor Squadron.
