## **EMBLEM**



Per fess abased wavy Azure and Celeste two barrulets wavy of the first; overall a cross coupé winged elevated Or; all within a diminished bordure per bordure Red and Yellow. Attached above the disc a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border. Attached below the disc a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "GLOBAL CARE" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The disc with wavy base symbolizes the earth and reflects the unit's global commitment and response capabilities. The winged red cross denotes the squadron's specialized medical expertise.
