OPERATIONS

Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 15 October 1921 as the 439th Squadron (Headquarters), assigned to the Sixth Army and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Phoenix, AZ, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Redesignated as the 439th Headquarters Squadron on 25 January 1923. Initiated on 26 February 1923 in Waco, TX. Withdrawn from the Eighth Corps Area on 31 March 1924 and allotted to the Ninth Corps Area. Reorganized in 1924 at San Jose, CA. Inactivated on 1 September 1928 at San Jose by relief of personnel. Demobilized on 1 October 1933.
