It was during the late 1944-to-late 1945 time period that several additional squadrons were attached to the 412th FG. These were comprised of the 361st FS, 615th Air Engineering Squadron (AES), and the 624th Air Material Squadron (AMS). Another lesser-known P-59 unit - the 440th Army Air force Base Unit, a training squadron - was in operation at Santa Maria by late June 1945.
