Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 15 October 1921 as the 442nd Squadron (Pursuit), assigned to the 313th Pursuit Group (First Army), and allotted to the First Corps Area. Initiated on 17 December 1921 at West Roxbury, MA. Redesignated as the 442nd Pursuit Squadron on 25 January 1923. Relieved from assignment to the First Army 31 March 1924 and assigned to the General Headquarters Reserve. Demobilized on 1 October 1933.
