EMBLEM



On an ultramarine azure disc, an argent oscilloscope is located at the chief position, an atom with a gules nucleus and gules system of electrons and air force or rings is positioned at fess point, and a sable meter with a vert face and or pointer at middle base. Two gules lightning bolts are positioned on the dexter and on the sinister side of the disc. The disc is bordered in air force or and two or scrolls are attached above and below the disc. The one above bears the unit's motto "gallantly charged"; and the one below bears the unit's designation. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The emblem is symbolic of the unit. The field of ultramarine blue represents the sky and the devotion required of air force personnel. The silver grey oscilloscope and meter, with their green faces and air force yellow sinewave, indicator and dials, represent the tools which signify the strength of the squadron motto. The atom represents the strength and excellence of the air force electronic age. The ultramarine blue lettering of the emblem signifies the sincerity of pride in the squadron.
