Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 2 July 1923 as the 482nd Balloon Service Company (DNG), and replaced the 132nd Balloon Service Company (Deferred National Guard list) in the mobilization plans. Assigned to the 53rd Balloon Group (redesignated as the 553rd Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Initiated by June 1932 at Richmond, MI. Inactivated by July 1937 at Richmond by relief of personnel. Reorganized about January 1938 at Detroit, MI.
