Headquarters United States Air Forces in Europe issued Special Order #GB-43 on 28 June 1984 redesignating the unit as the 485th Security Police Group effective 1 August 1984. The orders were also happy to establish the 485th Missile Security Squadron and the 485th Security Police Squadron. On 1 August 1984, the first Guard mount for the new group was held at 0700 hrs,

and resulted in initial post manning by both Security and Law Enforcement personnel assigned. Later, on 2 January 1985, Security personnel began operations in the current Weapons Storage Area; a milestone towards supporting the introduction of the Ground Launched Cruise Missile to continental Europe for protection of the western alliance's under agreement made within the North Atlantic Treaty Organization.
