## OPERATIONS

The 505th Training Group at Hurlburt Field AFB, Fla., reports to the 505th Command and Control Wing. Constituted as 615 Technical School Squadron (Special) on March 19, 1942, the 505th Training Group took its name on Jan. 22, 1943. The Group was disbanded in 1944, but reactivated on March 12, 2004.

The 505th Training Group exists to provide training and system support to Combatant and Numbered Air Force Commanders, joint and allied partners.

The 505 TRG mission is to provide education and training to joint/coalition warfighters on air and space command and control weapons systems and procedures at the operational level of war. Our mission statement establishes we train the future operational and tactical operators and leaders of the USAF, along with Joint and allied partners, through advanced educational and tactical courses and exercises. We also support the integration of air, space, and cyberspace capabilities, systems, forces and operations, in and through all domains, to deliver precise effects for the Joint Force Commander across the full range of military operations.

#### Organizations

To execute this mission, the 505 TRG oversees operations of three squadrons: the 505th Training Squadron, 705th Training Squadron, and the 505th Communications Squadron at Hurlburt Field AFB, Florida. The 505th Communications Squadron also has an element at Nellis AFB with the 505th Operation Squadron.

#### 505th Training Squadron

The mission of the 505th Training Squadron is to train a professional force of command & control warfighters capable of manning crew positions in a Falconer or tailored Falconer Air and Space Operations Center. Provide joint and multi-national warfighters with world-class education and training on C2 organizations along with the processes and systems used to employ air & space forces at the operational level of war.

#### 705th Training Squadron

The mission of the 705th Training Squadron is to conduct resident advanced academic courses, develop and maintain the Air Force's Operational Lessons Learned Community of Practice, develop Air and Space Operations Center Operational-level Techniques and Procedures with inputs for Air Force Tactic, Techniques and Procedures, Air Force Instructions, and doctrine rewrites, provide operational-level air and space C2 expertise & mentorship, and admin the CSAF-directed Operational Warfighter Program and Operational Command Training Program support to training and exercises.
