#### **EMBLEM**

On a medium blue disc an Air Force blue ink blot; surmounting the ink blot an Air Force golden yellow staff of Aesculapius (god of healing), outlines and details red, winged red, outlines and details Air Force blue, encircled by three electrons in orbit, white. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Our emblem symbolizes the primary mission of the hospital and indicates the three aspects of aviation medicine, psychological, physical, and preventive medicine. There are represented by an ink blot, the staff of Aesculapius and electrons in orbit. Since the 506th Tactical Fighter Wing has an atomic capability, the preventive medicine program consists largely of radiation problems. The aggressive nature of the snake and wings indicate the fly-away medical support to an attack organization. The blue background represents the sky, the primary theater of operations for the USAF. The emblem displays the official Air Force Colors, ultramarine blue and golden yellow, and the national colors red, white, and blue. (Approved, 12 Mar 1959)
