EMBLEM

On a disc Or, two wings displayed Azure, suppressed by a mullet Argent, surmounted by a dollar sign Vert, all within a narrow border Black. Attached above the disc, a Green scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "NE ARGENTUM NE ADLEGATIO" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a Green scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "509TH COMPROLLER SQ" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The wings symbolize the heritage of the Squadron's parent unit, the 509th Bomb Wing. The dollar sign represents the mission in Financial Management. The star emphasizes the highest state of readiness.
