On a blue disc edged with a narrow yellow border, issuing from base a green demi-globe with vertical axis, rimmed and gridlined yellow below a compass, north-south and east-west points red and white, all other points green and white, surmounting the compass a yellow disc; above the globe in dexter fess gray aircraft affronte with yellow windows garnished blue, and in sinister fess a gray wrench and a screw driver with yellow handle detailed blue and gray blade in saltire surmounted by yellow five-pointed star. Attached above the disc a blank yellow scroll. Attached below the disc a yellow scroll inscribed "PRO PATRIA" in red letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The ultra marine blue signifies the sky, which is the primary field for Air Force operations. The yellow throughout the emblem signifies our commitment to excellence showing forth in all our endeavors. The globe represents the worldwide mission of this squadron and the Air Force Reserve. The aircraft represents that we are an aircraft maintenance squadron. The compass rose signifies our commitment to mobility as we are ready to go in any direction to support the Air Force and the United States. The screwdriver and wrench are traditional symbols of maintenance. This is our heritage. The star signifies our dedication to outstanding performance in our field.
