Initiated in April 1922 with headquarters at St. Louis, MO. Redesignated as HQ, 547th Balloon Group on 20 February 1924. Relieved from assignment to the XVII Corps 1 October 1933 and assigned to the VII Corps. Concurrently, reorganized and redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 547th Balloon Group. Redesignated as HHS, 65th Balloon Group on 1 January 1938. Concurrently withdrawn from the Organized Reserve and allotted to the Regular Army. Disbanded 31 May 1942.
