## **MISSION**

The 558th Aircraft Sustainment Group provides technical and logistics support to 23 weapon systems in over 60 countries. Responsible for the acquisition of new/improved capabilities as well as the sustainment of existing mature and proven systems/subsystems, with 20 airframes in 61 countries/over 3,900 aircraft used by USAF, international allies and other government agencies (Navy, NASA, Forest Service, etc). Also responsible for planning, programming, and budgeting for modification and structural upgrade programs to sustain and improve the T37/T-38 fleet of aircraft. Responsibilities involve acquisition, modification, engineering/technical support, maintenance and repair of 26 simulator programs that include over 2,000 training devices. Total budget authority exceeds \$650 million annually.
